- 85 million people need emergency food aid
- 49 countries are experiencing or recovering from armed conflict
- 47 countries are governed by authoritarian rulers
- 97 countries are considered very or highly corrupt

USAID is the lead US agency for international disaster response.




- Join with local actors in the field, inside and outside of government.
